

Isobel Coleman is a foreign policy and global development expert who most recently served as the Deputy Administrator of USAID. Prior to USAID, she was the chief operating Officer of GiveDirectly where she helped scale the organization's innovative model of providing direct cash transfers to the extreme poor. Under President Obama, she served as the U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations for Management, Reform and Special Political Affairs. In that role she represented the United States in the UN General Assembly and on the UN Security Council with responsibility for Africa and peacekeeping issues. A former senior fellow at the Council on Foreign Relations, she has written extensively about foreign affairs. She began her career at McKinsey & Co. and holds degrees from Princeton and Oxford University.
